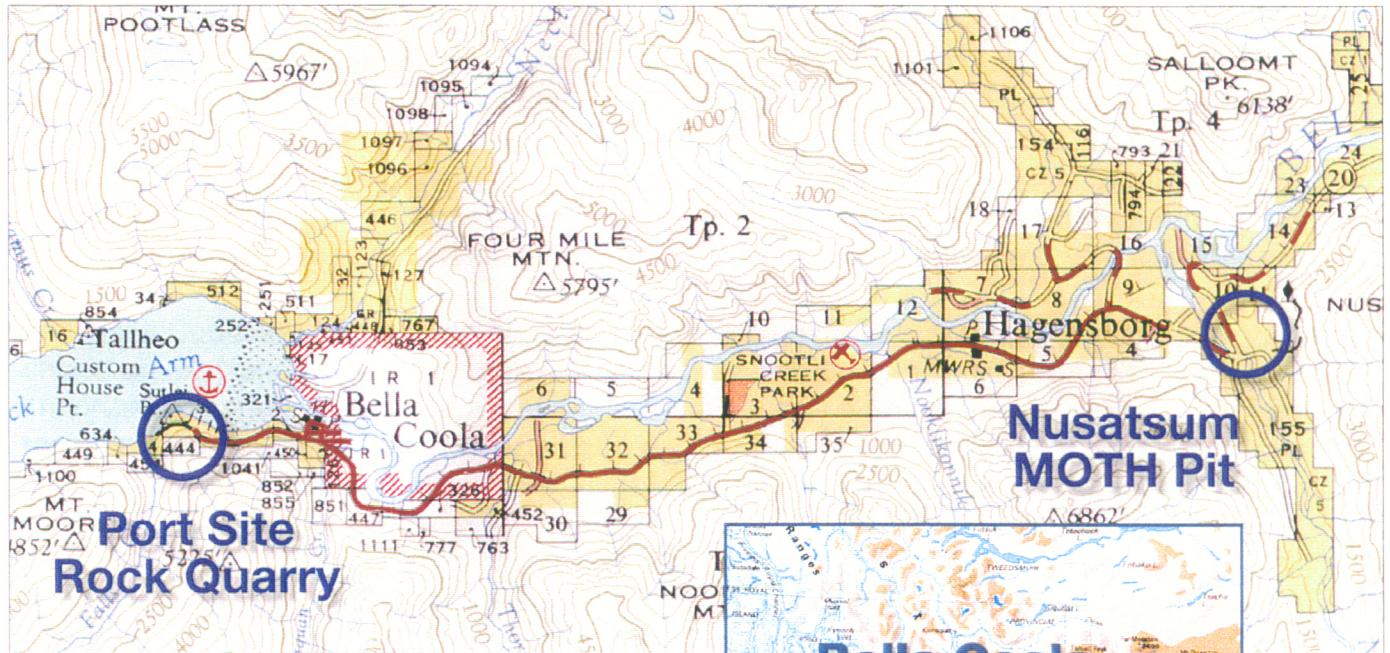

Land Use planning in the Central Coast region is handled, in concert, through several governmental agencies. In addition to the Central Coast Regional District, the Land Use Coordination Office contributes to the long range planning efforts. The Land Use Coordination Office (LUCO) was created in January 1994 to define a corporate vision for land use planning in British Columbia and to oversee, coordinate, evaluate and report to Cabinet on ministries' work to deliver the provincial land-use strategy. LUCO's mandate is to improve corporate direction and coordination of all inter-ministry strategic land-use planning initiatives.
